CLOTHING AND KIT LIST FOR NEW BOYS

House Notes 2022



MARKING

All items, including home clothes, must be clearly marked with the boy's initials and surname; articles requiring washing must also have the House laundry number (L#) after the name (e.g. J.Bloggs L13). The School's uniform suppliers will sew nametapes onto items bought from them.

Please use fabric nametapes in red on white for clothes; marking in pen is not acceptable. Please ensure that shirts are marked at the back of the collar, socks on the leg, and underpants/boxers on the waistband. Please sew nametapes on fully and not in loops.

Please send Matron at least 20 nametapes before the start of term. Boys should ask the uniform supplier to name newly bought items during term time where possible. New home clothes should be labelled during the School holidays.

FURNISHINGS

Each room is fully fitted with all necessary furniture, including a safe; nothing extra is needed. Boys should bring a named pillow, duvet and two duvet covers. Named mattress toppers are acceptable but cannot be stored at School over the summer holidays.

ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT

Appliances such as hairdryers, sandwich makers, fan heaters, fridges and kettles constitute fire risks and are not permitted.

ADDITIONAL ITEMS

Any item brought from this list should be clearly marked.

- Cutlery set, plate, bowl and mug (named)

TRUNKS

Please do not bring a trunk; they are too cumbersome, cause too much damage and take up too much storage space. Soft bags work best, with a small one for exeats.

STORAGE

Boys will need to take most belongings home in the summer; only boys from overseas will be able to store all their belongings.

INSURANCE

The School insurance does not cover boys' personal electronic equipment and mobile phones. We suggest you enquire if your son's items can be covered on your personal or house insurance.

HATS

Hats must be varnished and named before term begins.
